

**AS FROM 1 JULY 2019, THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION'S ENROLMENT POLICY NOW REQUIRES A**

**100-POINT RESIDENTIAL ADDRESS CHECK FOR STUDENTS WISHING TO ENROL AT A NSW GOVERNMENT SCHOOL.**

Documents from the list below totalling 100 points must be provided to the school along with the child's original Birth Certificate/Passport and up-to-date Immunisation History Statement.

- **DOCUMENTS MUST SHOW THE FULL NAME OF THE CHILD'S PARENT.**

<p><b>Any of the following documents</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Private rental agreement for a period of at least 6 months,</li> <li>• Centrelink payment statement showing home address,</li> <li>• Electoral roll statement.</li> </ul>	<p>20 Points</p>
<p><b>Any of the following documents</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Electricity or gas bill showing the service address*</li> <li>• Water bill showing the service address*</li> <li>• Telephone or internet bill showing the service address*</li> <li>• Drivers licence or government issued ID showing home address*</li> <li>• Home building or home contents insurance showing the service address</li> <li>• Motor vehicle registration or compulsory third party insurance policy showing home address</li> <li>• Bank Statement*</li> <li>• Statutory declaration stating the child's residential address, how long they have lived there, and any supporting information or documentation of this.</li> </ul>	<p>15 Points</p>
