


Dress the Bear!

All artists and designers seek inspiration in one form or another from each other or from nature to create. The focus on clothes provides an opportunity for students to springboard into Fashion Design. Discuss fashion culture and styles. Search inspiration from famous Fashion Designers to inspire a new wardrobe for Bear.



- Blackline master of Bear on 200gsm white card
- Scissors
- · Tape
- · Paddle pop stick
- Blu-Tack
- Waterproof pen
- · Watercolours or gouache
- Watercolour brush

How to Make

- Using a waterproof pen, design Bear's pants and singlet and his new jumper with imaginative patterns and motifs.
- Over the top of the pen designs, paint bear and his jumper.
- When dry, cut out the bear, stand, and jumper. Make sure you don't cut off the tabs that will hold Bear's new jumper in place.
- ▶ Reinforce the back of Bear by taping paddle pop sticks as a spine.
- ► Fold the tabs on the jumper and place the jumper in position on Bear. You may wish to tape the tabs into position.
- ► Cut the slots near Bear's feet and on the stand. Insert them into each other. Secure with Blu-Tack to make Fashion Bear stand.
- ▶ Create a display of Fashionista Bears!
